The Office of Inspector General released a new report tonight outlining wasteful spending by the Nagin Administration. Ed Quatrevaux's Office says the city's contract with Telecommunications Development Corporation grew from \$450,000 to more than five million dollars. That resulted in \$750,000 of wasteful spending between October 2009 and May 2010. The report also showed that paying TDC to staff the city's Information Systems division cost the city \$960,000 more than it would have cost to hire city employees to perform the work.

TDC handled IT related work for the city. One of the recommendations from the Inspector General's office is that the city limit the amount of maximum compensation increases through contract amendments.

Quatrevaux said, "City officials responded positively to the recommendations made in this report and have already taken steps to reduce the cost of this contract."
